



The Nordic Championship for Scolastic Teams 2017 Laugar-Saelingsdal, Iceland September 22nd-September 25th 2017

Welcome to the Nordic Championship for Scolastic Teams 2017, hosted by the Icelandic Chess Federation.

Location and accommodation

The tournament and the accommodation will take place in Laugar-Saelingsdal which is situated in the west coast of Iceland – 170 kilometres distance from Reykjavik. <https://www.hoteledda.is/is/hotels/hotel-edda-laugar-i-saelingsdal>, This website is for the hotel which is open in the summertime, but shows the housing and surroundings.

Travel

The organizer will arrange busses from/to Keflavik Airport and from/to Reykjavik. **The bus will leave Keflavik airport and Faxafen 12, Reykjavik on September 22nd at 15.00 and early morning September 25th from Laugar to Keflavik Airport and Reykjavik.** So you should book the flights early morning on arrival and in the afternoon when you depart.

The price for a return ticket is Ikr. 8000.-

Tournament rules

The teams are scholastic teams with four players + one reserve from the same school.

There are two groups:

Group A – players from 0-10 grade (max 17 years)

Group B - players from 0-6 grade (max 13 years)

The teams are qualified through the national federations scholastic chess championships in each country.

Both groups will play five rounds – round robin. The time control is 90 min. per game with additional 30 seconds per move starting from the first move.

Costs

The Icelandic Chess Federation covers accommodation and food for four players and a reserve in each group and one team leader for each team.

The cost for accompanying persons:

Double room	Ikr. 33.000. per person (full board)
Single room	Ikr. 40.000 per person (fullboard)

Accompanying persons have to pay their national federation, which in return will be invoiced by the organizer.
